Kalaignar Centenary Super Speciality Hospital, has been Awarded as Gold status by Indian Green Building Council. The Chairman, Indian Green Building Council Chennai Chapter Mr.Ajith Kumar Chordia presented the Medal and Certificate to Hon'ble Minister of Public Works, Highways and Minor Ports Department Thiru.E.V.Velu at Secretariat, Chennai.

The Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu has made an announcement during the birthday celebration of former Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu Hon'ble Muthamilaringar Dr.Kalaignar M.Karunanidhi on 03.06.2021 for Establishment of Multi Super Speciality Hospital in the premises of King Institute of Preventive Medicine and Research, Guindy, Chennai – 32 at a cost of Rs.240.54 Crores. This Hospital Building was completed in 15 months and was inaugurated by Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu Thiru. M. K. Stalin on 15.03.2023.

The Construction work was completed 4 months ahead of schedule by the continuous monitoring of the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu and the instructions of the Hon'ble Minister of Public works Department and Hon'ble Minister of Health and Family welfare Department. Within a year of its inception, this Hospital has performed outstanding works to cure lakhs of patient and has earned a special place among Tamil Nadu Government Hospitals.

It was registered with the Indian Green Building Council on 20.03.2023 as a Green Building designed with the following facilities based on the Biophilic design concept with a healing architecture.

The Hospital building has been designed as a Green Building to protect the Environment during construction using Green Certified Construction materials, recycled construction materials, water efficient plumbing fixtures, dual plumbing

arrangements for using recycled water, Energy efficient electric fixtures, Solid waste management (Vermicompost) to increase energy conservation. The Corridors have been designed as Green Corridors and the building is designed to world class standards with large windows and courtyards. The concept of colour psychology has been incorporated considering the positive effects of colours on patients.

The 500 KLD Sewage Treatment plant (STP) and a 30 KLD Effluent Treatment plant have been setup to treat 100 % of waste water generated onsite, so as to avoid polluting the receiving streams.

This is the first building developed by Public Works Department which is designed as a green building in the Tamil Nadu Government Hospitals. The Indian Green Building Council (IGBC-Healthcare projects) has awarded gold rating to this Hospital building.

This certificate and medal were presented by Mr.Ajith Kumar Chordia, the Chairman of Indian Green Building Council - Chennai chapter to Hon'ble Minister of Public works Department Mr.E.V.Velu on 24.09.2024.

During the event, Additional Chief Secretary to Government, Health and Family Welfare Department Mrs.Supriya Sahu, I.A.S., Engineer-in-Chief, Public Works Department Mr.K.P.Sathyamurthy and other Senior Government Officials were present.
