

Hon'ble Tamil Nadu Chief Minister Thiru. M.K.Stalin's Dravidian Model Rule

46 new factories have been opened since 2021!

Job opportunities have been provided to 139,725 youth and women!

Due to the remarkable achievements in industrial growth, Tamil Nadu stands as a premier state in India!

This has been confirmed by the Union Ministry of Statistics' research!

Since taking office, the Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu, Thiru M.K. Stalin, has been driving remarkable encouragement for industrial growth, resulting in the continuous opening of various new factories in Tamil Nadu. Through these initiatives, the youth community is gaining employment opportunities.

After the commencement of the Dravidian model government in 2021, efforts have been made to attract new industrial investments through investor conferences with the goal of making Tamil Nadu a trillion-dollar economy by 2030.

In the first phase, investor conferences were held in cities such as Chennai, Coimbatore, and Thoothukudi under the banner of "Tamil Nadu – The First Address for Investors," attracting investments worth ₹1,90,803 crores, creating employment for 2,80,600 people.

In the second phase, visits were made to the UAE, Singapore, Malaysia, and Japan, resulting in investments worth ₹7,441 crores, which generated job opportunities for 17,371 individuals.

In the third phase, during the 'World Investors Conference' organized by the Tamil Nadu government at the Nandambakkam Trade Center in Chennai on January 7 and 8, 2024, unprecedented investments of ₹6,64,180 crores were secured through 631 agreements, providing direct job opportunities for 14,54,712 individuals and indirect opportunities for 12,35,945 individuals, totaling 26,90,657 job guarantees.

In the fourth phase, the Chief Minister visited Spain on January 27, 2024, where he met officials from the Ministry of Economy and Trade and representatives from the Spain Business Federation. He highlighted the industrial opportunities in Tamil Nadu, the incentives provided by the government, and the available skilled workforce, inviting them to start business in Tamil Nadu. As a result, Memorandum of Understanding for investments worth ₹3,440 crores were signed.

In the fifth phase, on September 22, 2024, the Chief Minister visited the USA to meet with leading global investors. He invited them to explore industrial opportunities and skilled human resources in Tamil Nadu, leading to the signing of 19 Memorandum of Understanding that created 11,516 new job opportunities for Tamil youth.

The factories opened under the Dravidian model government will ensure that the pride of this administration is recognized worldwide.

On August 21, 2024, the Chief Minister inaugurated 19 factories with investments of ₹17,616 crores at an event held in Chennai by the Department of Industrial Investment Promotion and Trade. These include:

- Omran factory producing medical equipment in Tiruvallur district
- Hi-Pi company manufacturing electrical machinery in Kanchipuram district
- Motherson Electronics factory in Kanchipuram district
- Jurosin Development Private Limited's industrial park in Kanchipuram district
- TVS factory producing motor vehicle spare parts in Tiruvallur district
- L&T's innovation centre in Chennai
- Ronald Nissan Technology and Trade Center in Kanchipuram district
- Sundaram Fasteners' manufacturing units across several districts including Chennai and Tiruvallur
- Chemical factory under the Sjoy Group in Kanchipuram and Ranipet districts
- Garment manufacturing factory by Enas Ramraj in Erode and Tirupur districts
- Capnyn's factory producing medical products in Tiruvallur district
- Vek Industries' general manufacturing factory in Krishnagiri district
- Milky Mist food processing factory in Erode district
- General production expansion factory of Grudwind Private Limited from Switzerland in Kanchipuram district
- Expansion of Hypro Healthcare factory in Kanchipuram district
- Royal Enfield's motor vehicle factory in Tiruvannamalai district
- Motor vehicle spare parts factory by Grupo Costos from Spain in Kanchipuram district
- Chemical factory by GP Salfonet in Tiruvallur district
- Medical equipment manufacturing factory by Motherson Health's in Kanchipuram district

Hon'ble Tamil Nadu Chief Minister Thiru. M.K. Stalin started the production in all these 19 factories. These 19 factories have collectively provided job opportunities for 64,968 youth, representing a total investment of ₹17,616 crores.

In addition, several other factories have been established and are engaged in production.

Alongside inaugurating these 19 factories, the Chief Minister laid the foundation for 28 new factories with an investment of ₹51,157 crores, which will provide employment for 41,835 youths.

Furthermore, the Chief Minister laid the foundation for a vehicle manufacturing factory of Tata Motors in Ranipet, with an investment of ₹9,000 crores, directly contributing to employment for 5,000 youths.

The MoU for this factory will be signed in March 2024, with construction expected to be completed in 6 months, reflecting the commitment of the Dravidian model government towards industrial growth.

Comparison with Previous Government

In the context of the Dravidian model government's initiatives in opening new factories, comparing these achievements with the previous government, industrial development efforts will further clarify the accomplishments of this government.

Between 2016 and 2021, under the previous administration, only 21 factories were set up with MoUs worth ₹15,543 crores, creating jobs for 10,316 youth, with only 12 factories actually commencing production.

However, in just three years, the Dravidian model government has attracted investments worth ₹9.74 lakh crores, opening 27 new factories that can provide jobs for a total of 31 lakh youth. In addition to the 19 factories inaugurated, a total of 46 new factories have been opened. More factories are expected to be established soon. These achievements of the Dravidian model government in industrial development are being recognized on a national level, as confirmed by a recent report from the Union Ministry of Statistics.

Appreciation from the Union Ministry of Statistics for Tamil Nadu's Industrial Strength:

The Union Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation, through its field surveys and census for the year 2023-2024, reported that job opportunities in the manufacturing sector in Tamil Nadu have increased by 7.5%. It further stated that Tamil Nadu holds the top position in the country for the highest number of factories and job opportunities.

Therefore, the continuous achievements of Tamil Nadu affirm its status as the leading state in industrial growth in India.
